GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The competition regulations (WB), the legal regulations (RO) and the anti-doping regulations (ADO) of the German Swimming Federation e.V. (DSV) apply in their current version. All DSV clubs, divisions and starting communities are eligible to compete, provided they have the rights of the association. Furthermore, all clubs and selection teams of federations affiliated to the World Aquatics Federation are eligible to compete. For physically, visually, mentally and generally disabled athletes with the corresponding classification certificate, the competition regulations of the German Disabled Sports Association (DBS) must also be applied.

2. According to the decision of the Technical Committee Swimming of 4 November 2017, 8-, 9- and 10-year-old athletes may complete a maximum of 6 starts (incl. relay starts) per day.

3. Entries must be sent on the entry list (DSV Form 102) or as an entry file in the current DSV format together with the entry form (DSV Form 101) to:

Foreign clubs are permitted to submit entries in LENEX format.

Entries for the event must be submitted by a club; entries from individual swimmers cannot be accepted.

By submitting the entries, the club confirms the fitness of its registered swimmers in accordance with § 11 WB-AT.

4. Provisional closing date for entries is Saturday, 05.04.2025, at 20:00

Final entry deadline is Thursday 17 April 2025 at 20:00.

5. The final entry confirmation will be sent on Monday 21 April 2025. The receipt of entries will be confirmed by an entry confirmation.

If entries are submitted by e-mail, they will only be deemed to have been received and readable when the registering club has received confirmation. The organizer asks to be contacted if no confirmation is received 48 hours after the final entry deadline.

6. The lane assignments will be made independently of age group/category based on the submitted times in accordance with § 121 WB-FT SW.

The preliminary heats in the competitions over the 100m distances as well as the preliminary heats and semi-finals over 50m freestyle are seeded across all age groups in accordance with § 122 WB-FT SW. The lane allocation for the direct deciding heats and the finals is based on the entry time or the performance from the preliminary heat (§ 123 WB-FT SW).

The lanes for the 800m and 1500m freestyle will be allocated within the respective age group (2012 to 2010 or 2009 and older) according to the entry time.

Entry results and protocols in paper form will not be issued.

7. The organizer reserves the right to change the starting times depending on the number of entries and to hold the competition on fewer than eight lanes.

In the event of a timely deregistration according to § 131 (15) WB-FT SW, four substitute swimmers will be nominated for all final and semi-final heats, who will move up according to the number of deregistered swimmers. In accordance with § 131 (15) WB-FT SW, the renunciation of a replacement place is also subject to deregistration.

12. The entry results and the protocol will be published on the internet at www.schwimmen.dsw-1912.de and made available to the clubs exclusively as a PDF file by e-mail. Current information on the event, an online protocol and live timing can also be found on the event website at <https://www.isf-da.de>.

13. Technical Officials:

32 technical official positions must be filled in order to organize the event. If there are five or more starts in a section, at least one technical official must be provided for this section. The remaining technical official positions will be requested pro rata according to the number of entries per section in addition to the minimum referee. The organizer will inform the clubs of the exact number of technical officials to be provided for each section once the entry lists have been compiled.

The clubs will receive information on the number of technical officials to be provided when the final entry confirmation is sent on Monday 21 April 2025.

It is possible to nominate the technical officials to be provided per section by name up to two days before the start of the event and this will help to shorten the technical official meeting. Requests for technical official will be honored as far as possible. However, it is not always possible to fulfil these requests. The final allocation of the judging panel is the responsibility of the referees in charge of the event during the technical officials' meeting. The technical officials' meeting always begins 45 minutes before the start of the section.

Technical officials may not start as swimmers in the competitions of the same section.

14. Scoring and awards:

Scoring will be in accordance with the abbreviations and age restrictions specified in the competition order.

- a. Age group classification (AG.): The age groups 2015 to 2007 are classified by year.
- b. Open classification (Open): All athletes will be ranked in one classification regardless of year.
- c. For the 100m distances and the 50m freestyle, the award ceremony for the open classification will be based on the result of the final heat.

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each classification will be awarded medals. An award ceremony will be held for these places. All participants will also receive certificates, which will be made available in digital form shortly after the event.

The organizer is not obliged to send medals that have not been collected if an award ceremony has taken place. In addition, numerous prize draws will be held during the event.

15. By submitting the entries, the club/team acknowledges the conditions of the event and declares that it and the registered athletes agree to the storage and publication of personal data. By submitting the entry, consent is also given for the publication of competition data in entry lists, results, and rankings.

The general information of the German Swimming Association (DSV) on data protection for participation in competitions under the DSV applies. These can be found on the DSV website (www.dsv.de/schwimmen/kontakt-veroeffentlichungen/sonstige-veroeffentlichungen) or requested from the office of the Hessian Swimming Association (Tel. 069/6789-208 or info@hessischer-schwimm-verband.de). Any consequences are governed by the competition regulations of the German Swimming Association (DSV).

16. The organizer assumes no liability for accidents, theft, or any kind of damage. By submitting their entry and participating, all participants accept the swimming pool's bathing and house rules.

17. A 6x25m warm-down pool will be available during the event.

18. Snacks and drinks will be offered on-site by the DSW12 Darmstadt catering team.
